8. Firewise Update:

Amador County Fair was successful, AFSC helped to host 2 booths and we have more interest in FireWise from this event. The Firewise program remains strong within Amador County. Megan went to River Pine and Fiddletown Townhalls and distributed the go-bags with the checklist that AFPD developed. Ponderosa FireWise is the newest FWC and we currently have 34 sites and 1 community working on becoming in good standing again and 4 communities in the wings who are working on implementing their Firewise program.

9. Partner Update:

CAL FIRE: Wildfire prevention grants should be releasing info in late Summer/early Fall. (AW)

AFPD: AFPD appreciated partnering with AFSC on the fair and the go-bags. Amdor Pine Evacuation Drill is scheduled for September 7th. AFPD continues to for FireWise Presentations. AFPD has been working on Risk Assessments for FireWise Communities. AFPD is planning to offer 'proper burning classes' upon request.

BLM: 14-acre Crestview Property in Pine Grove is roughly 2/3 treated. Funding for Rancheria Ridge Project has been awarded.
